



BYLAW NUMBER 305

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories to provide for the appointment of a Finance Officer pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22, s.59 (3).

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Fort Liard deems it necessary to dispose of personal property that can no longer be used by the Hamlet,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF FORT LIARD, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This by-law may be cited as the "**ASSET DISPOSAL BYLAW**".

INTERPRETATION

2. In this By-law:

"S.A.O."	means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Hamlet;
"Council"	means the council of the Hamlet;
"Hamlet"	means the Hamlet of Fort Liard, Northwest Territories; and,
"Mayor"	means the Mayor of the Hamlet.

3. That the Hamlet of Fort Liard dispose of the following:

Temco Sander TC10AS Sand spreader Serial Number 24671

4. The Sand Spreader can no longer be repaired and can no longer be used by the Hamlet.
5. This equipment has no resale value and will be destroyed.
