



## BYLAW NUMBER 302

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories to provide for the appointment of a Finance Officer pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22, s.59 (3).

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Fort Liard deems it necessary to dispose of personal property that is obsolete and non-reparable,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF FORT LIARD, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

### SHORT TITLE

1. This by-law may be cited as the "**ASSET DISPOSAL BYLAW**".

### INTERPRETATION

2. In this By-law:

3. That the Hamlet of Fort Liard dispose of the following Motorola radios which are no longer manufactured and replaceable.

| 1 each | Motorola Radio          | Model P25         |

4. The radios will be destroyed as the cost of removing Hamlet radio channels exceeds the possible disposal revenue.
