



BYLAW NUMBER 316

A Bylaw of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories to provide for financial administration of the Hamlet pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22, s.59 (3).

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Fort Liard deems it necessary to dispose of personal property that is no longer required by the Hamlet,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF FORT LIARD, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This by-law may be cited as the "**Asset Disposal Bylaw.**"

INTERPRETATION

2. In this Bylaw:

"S.A.O."	means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Hamlet;
"Council"	means the council of the Hamlet;
"Hamlet"	means the Hamlet of Fort Liard, Northwest Territories; and,
"Mayor"	means the Mayor of the Hamlet.

3. That the Hamlet of Fort Liard will dispose of the following:

HAY LAKE SKI HILL STRUCTURE Location Latitude 60-9-34 Longitude 123-24-55

4. The building is beyond economic repair, unsafe, and no longer required by the Hamlet.
5. Materials will be offered to community resident for removal and reclamation of the site.
