



## BYLAW NUMBER 304

---

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories to provide for the appointment of a Finance Officer pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22, s.59 (3).

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Fort Liard deems it necessary to dispose of personal property that is no longer required by the Hamlet,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF FORT LIARD, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

### SHORT TITLE

1. This by-law may be cited as the "**ASSET DISPOSAL BYLAW**".

### INTERPRETATION

2. In this By-law:

"S.A.O."	means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Hamlet;
"Council"	means the council of the Hamlet;
"Hamlet"	means the Hamlet of Fort Liard, Northwest Territories; and,
"Mayor"	means the Mayor of the Hamlet.

3. That the Hamlet of Fort Liard dispose of the following:

Caterpillar IT28F Integrated Tool Carrier Serial Number 3cL1404  
Complete with Blade, Bucket, and Forks.  
Sweepster Sweeper Pickup Head                      Serial Number 0318013  
Caterpillar Sweeper Head                                      Serial Number 7AW02503

4. The Integrated Tool Carrier and attachments are twenty-six years old and no longer manufactured Frequent repairs are expensive. This equipment is no longer required by the Hamlet.
5. This equipment will be sold by public tender to the highest bidder.
