



BYLAW NUMBER 303

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories to provide for the appointment of a Finance Officer pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22, s.59 (3).

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Fort Liard deems it necessary to dispose of personal property that is no longer required by the Hamlet,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF FORT LIARD, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This by-law may be cited as the "**ASSET DISPOSAL BYLAW**".

INTERPRETATION

2. In this By-law:

"S.A.O."	means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Hamlet;
"Council"	means the council of the Hamlet;
"Hamlet"	means the Hamlet of Fort Liard, Northwest Territories; and,
"Mayor"	means the Mayor of the Hamlet.

3. That the Hamlet of Fort Liard dispose of the following:


1995 Ford Fire Pumper Serial 1FDYF80B9SVA48237

4. The pumper truck cannot longer be NFPA certified as a primary fire truck as it is over twenty-five years old and is therefore no longer required by the Hamlet.
5. The pumper truck will be sold by public tender to the highest bidder.

READ a Second time this 12TH day of August 2021.

READ a Third time and finally passed this 16TH day of September 2021.
