Morge – the Minister, replied that the morgue is under construction – pad needs to be raised due as it is in the floodway.

Time Off for Funerals – community member request – SAO advised that Hamlet does not have authority to enforce community closure for funerals – Hamlet employees are given casual leave for community funerals - Hamlet bylaw provides for time off for employee family member's deaths.
