



BYLAW NUMBER 271

A Bylaw of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Fort Liard, in the Northwest Territories authorizing the lease of a certain parcel of land, pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22, s. 55 [1] (a).

WHEREAS it necessary to acquire land described hereunder to be used as a Public Cemetery;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF FORT LIARD, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

INTERPRETATION

1. In this Bylaw:

“Cemetery” means land set apart or used as a place for the interment or other disposal of dead bodies;

“Council” means the Council of the Hamlet;

“Hamlet” means the Hamlet of Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories;

“Schedule” means a schedule attached to and forming part of this by-law; and,

“SAO” means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Hamlet.

ACQUISITION

2. The Mayor and Senior Administrative Officer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Hamlet of Fort Liard to lease from the Commissioner of the Northwest Territories the Territorial lands described below -

a) Portion of Lot 1000 in the Hamlet of Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories according to Plan 1573 of the survey filed in the Land Titles Office for the Northwest Territories.

b) Portion of Lot 1000 in the Hamlet of Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories according to the attached sketch attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

3. Use of this land as a Public Cemetery is in accordance with the Hamlet Land Use Plan and Zoning Bylaw.

4. Lease payments will be made annually to the Government of the Northwest Territories at a rate set by the Department of Lands.

REPEAL

5. Bylaw 129 is repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE

6. This bylaw is effective upon third and final reading.

READ a First time this 21st day of October 2019.

READ a Second time this 21st day of October 2019.

READ a Third time and finally passed this 26th day of October 2019.

This bylaw has been made in accordance with the requirements of the Hamlets Act Section 77(1)(d), and the bylaws of the Hamlet of Fort Liard.
