



BYLAW NUMBER 275

A Bylaw of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Fort Liard, in the Northwest Territories to provide for the opening of municipal roads, pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22, s. 90[1].

WHEREAS it is desirable to close a municipal road within the municipal boundaries a it does not comply with legislated construction standards and within the floodway;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF FORT LIARD, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

INTERPRETATION

1. In this Bylaw:

- “Council” means the Council of the Hamlet;
- “Hamlet” means the Hamlet of Fort Liard in the Northwest Territories;
- “Road” means a road or bridge constructed, maintained, and under the jurisdiction of the hamlet over which the public is permitted to use for the passage of vehicles. It includes sidewalks, pathways, shoulders, and ditches adjacent to either side of the travelled portion.
- “Schedule” means a schedule attached to and forming part of this by-law; and,
- “SAO” means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Hamlet.

ROAD CLOSURE

2. The municipal road as indicated on the sketch illustrated on Schedule “A” attached to and forming part of this bylaw, is thereby closed.

EFFECTIVE DATE

3. This bylaw is effective upon third and final reading.
